Russia experienced a positive month in comparison to the rest of EMEA, rising by 5.1% compared to the 2.9% for in EMEA. This was despite the sell off toward the end of the month in global markets and the continued diplomatic ill feeling between Britain and Russia. The fund outperformed the Russian index, increasing by 5.7% with the positive upside again coming from several of the larger stocks in the fund. Evraz, a long steel producer has benefited from the increased demand coming from the domestic sector and increased by 18.5%. Sberbank continued to be a strong company for the fund, rising by 6.7%. The largest bank in Russia further benefited from having very limited exposure to the US subprime mortgage debacle. Unified Energy Systems announced FY 2006 which showed a massive increase in profits although the market is now focusing on how the restructuring of the generation, hydroelectric, transmission and distribution will take place.
